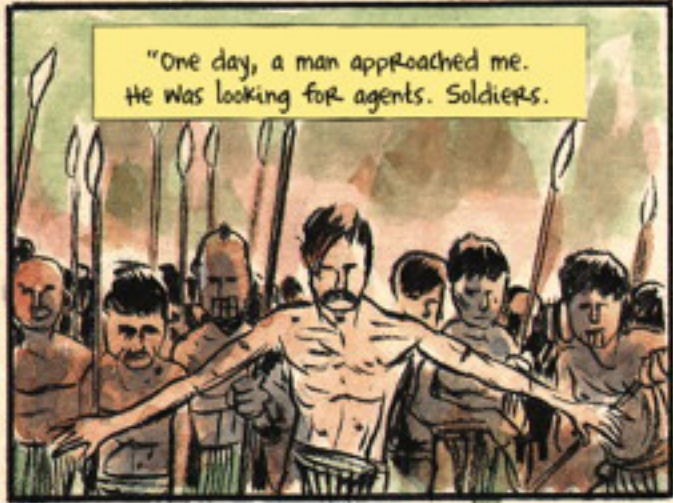
"It was there, at death's door, that I discovered the secret of immortality. As the jungle began to take my life, it also expanded my mind. I discovered the fountain of youth.

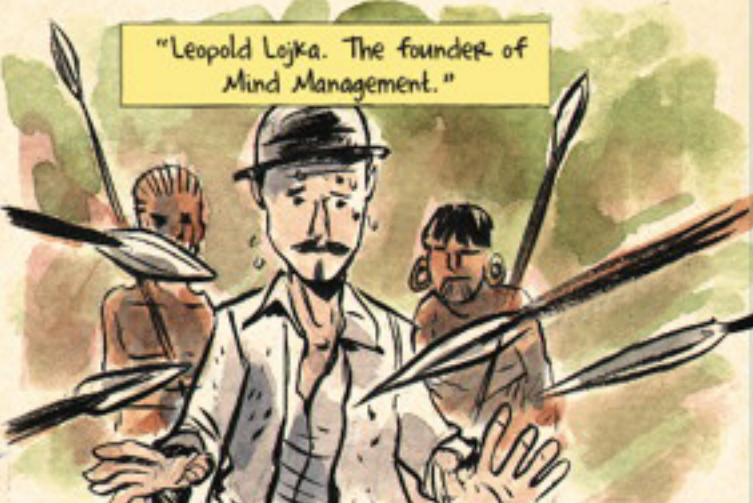

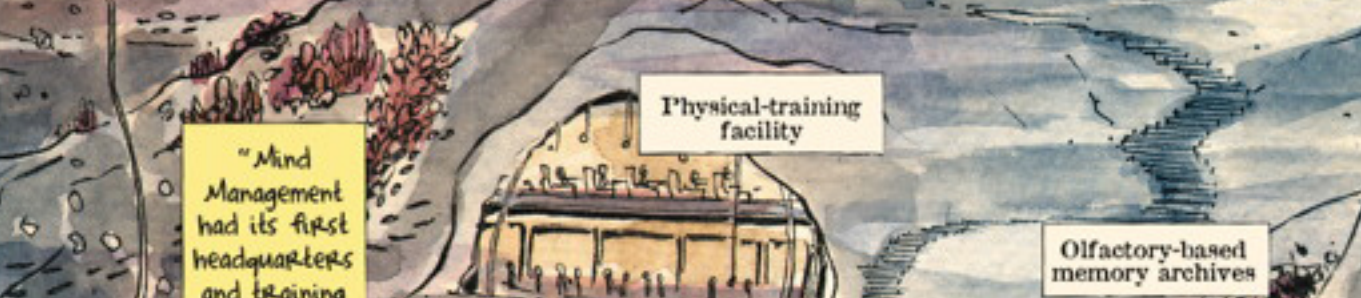
