AS CAPTAIN OF THIS SHIP, I CANNOT PERMIT YOU TO ENDANGER US ANY FURTHER.



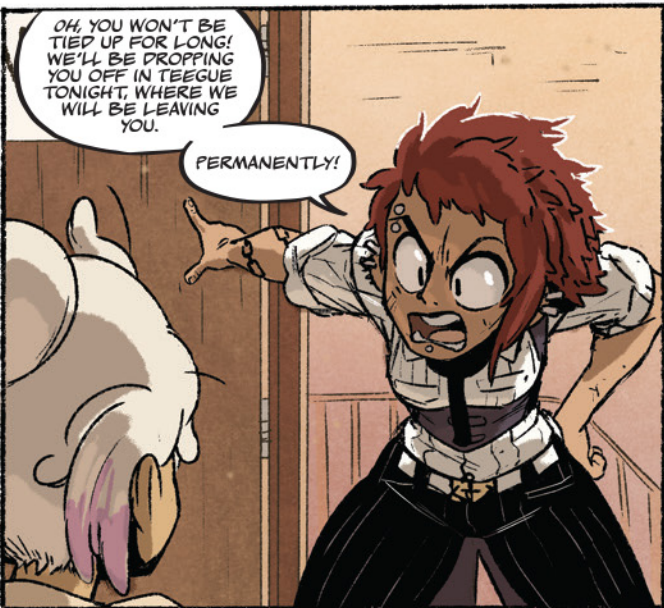
