...YOU TELL HIM THE TRUTH AND HE'LL LISTEN TO REASON.



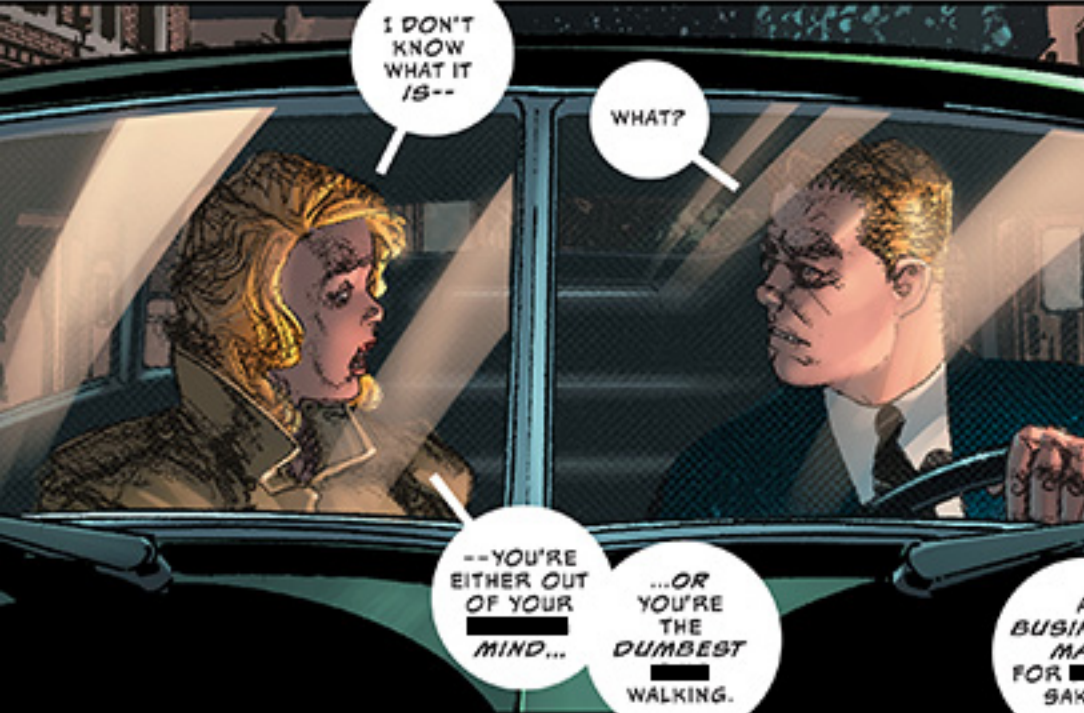

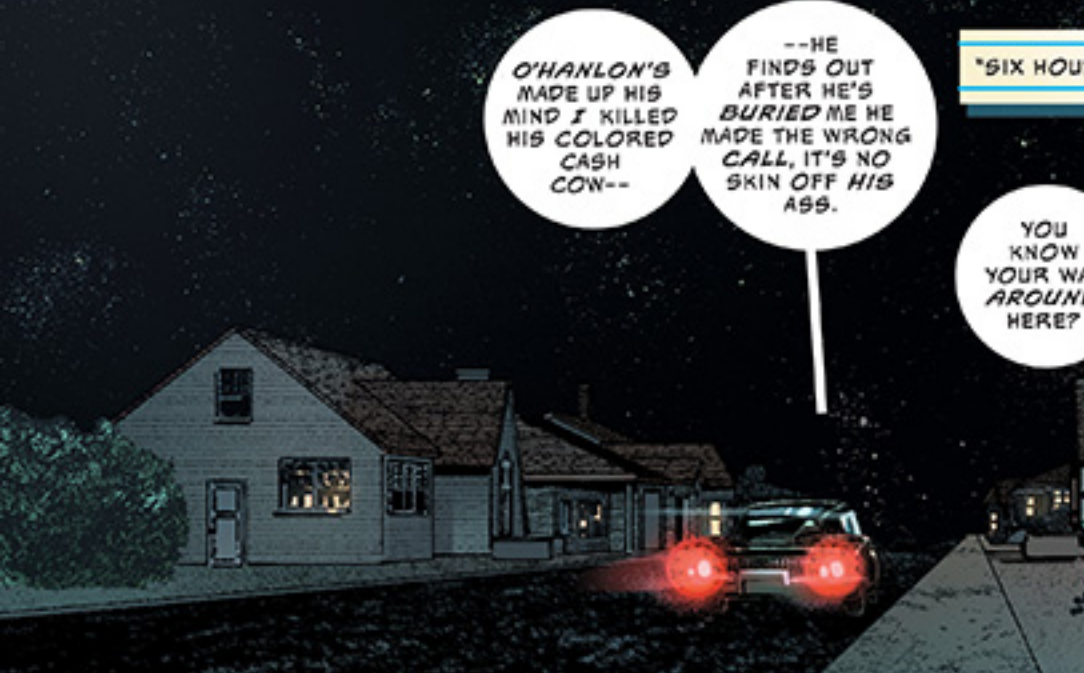


O'HANLON'S MADE UP HIS MIND I KILLED HIS COLORED CASH COW--

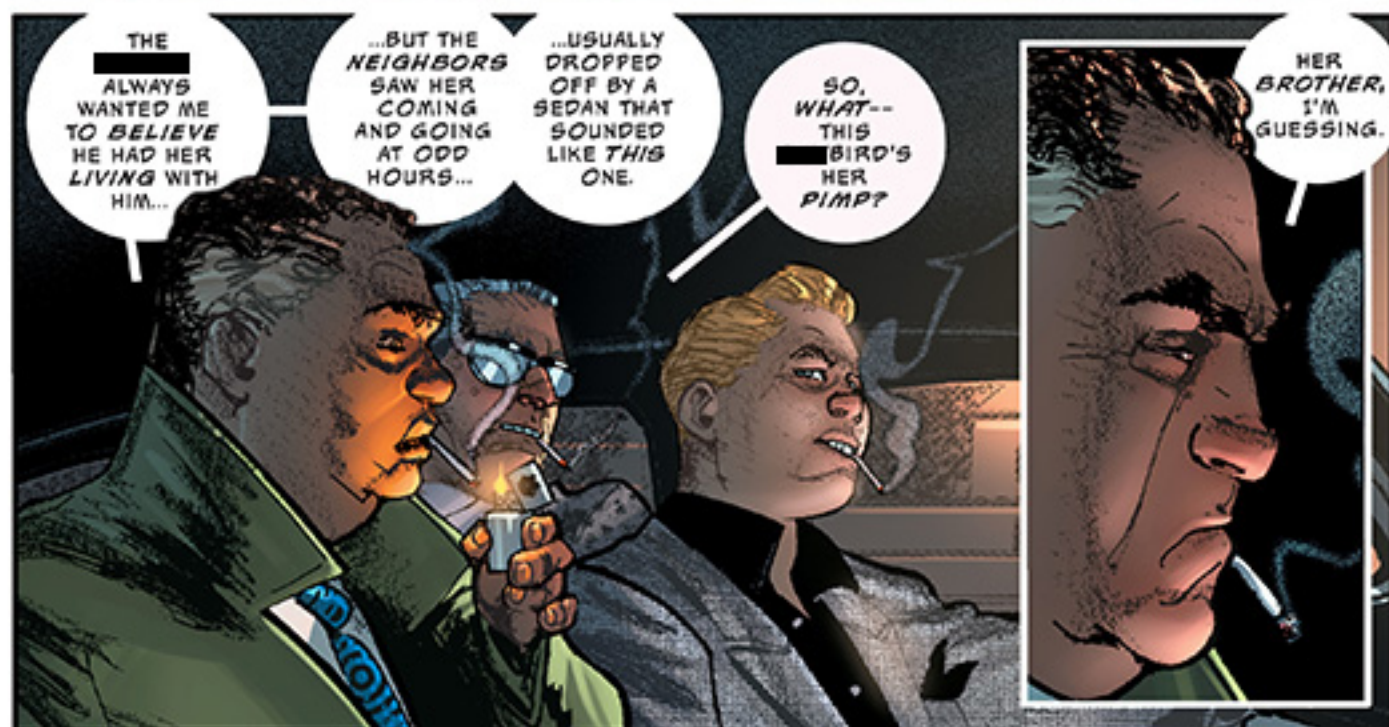




THIS IS EAST
