### Fit to Order

The first time I put on the armor, it was, like, twenty sizes too big for me. Within seconds, it shrank down from Kanjigar's measurements to my own and now fits me like a glove. A totally magical and medieval glove!



### The Daylight Sword

My blade may look like metal, but it's actually forged from pure daylight, a Troll's greatest weakness. I gotta admit, my knife skills in the kitchen definitely gave me an edge in swordplay. But thanks to Draal, I now wield Daylight like a pro. And with the Eye of Angor Rot in my Amulet, he won't be able to turn Daylight against me ever again.



## Full Eclipse

"For the doom of Gunmar, Eclipse is mine to command!" That's the other incantation I speak to transform my normal armor into the all-black Eclipse Armor. Powered by the Eye of Gunmar in my Amulet, the Eclipse Armor is basically my stealth-suit. Even my sword turns black with red engravings to help me blend into the darkness.



### The Shield

After I placed the Killstone into my Amulet, it unlocked a much-needed shield. With a flick of my wrist, the Shield unfolds from my left gauntlet like a paper fan—only much stronger. It's durable enough to withstand sword strikes and a point-blank punch from a Krubera. I've also been experimenting with the Shield's shiny surface. Maybe there's a way to reflect sunlight at any Troll enemies who are hiding in the shadows!

### The Glaives

Once I inserted the Birthstone into the Amulet, it rewarded me in the form of two blades: the Glaives. On their own, they make great weapons for close combat. But once they're combined, I can hurl the Glaives like a boomerang!
