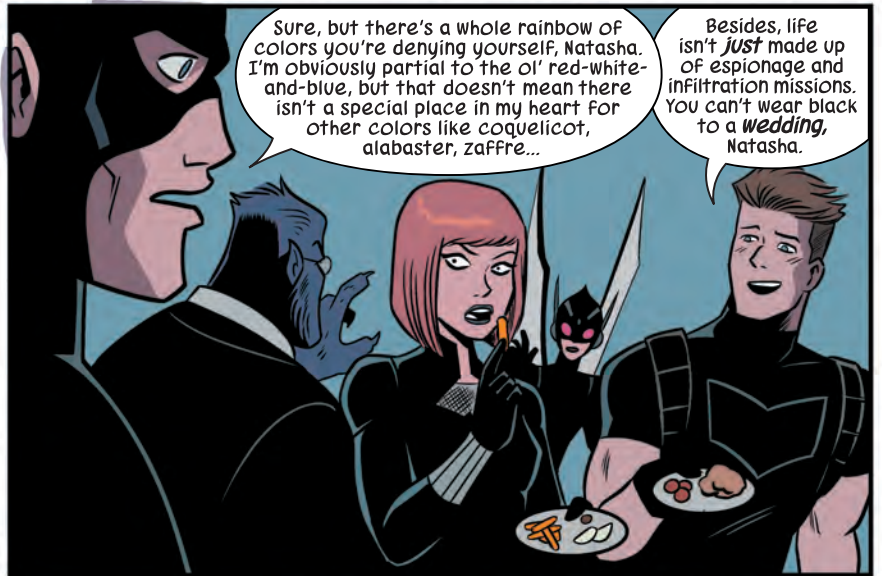
Espionage mission? Black For stealth.

Besides, life isn't *just* made up of espionage and infiltration missions. You can't wear black to a *wedding*, Natasha.

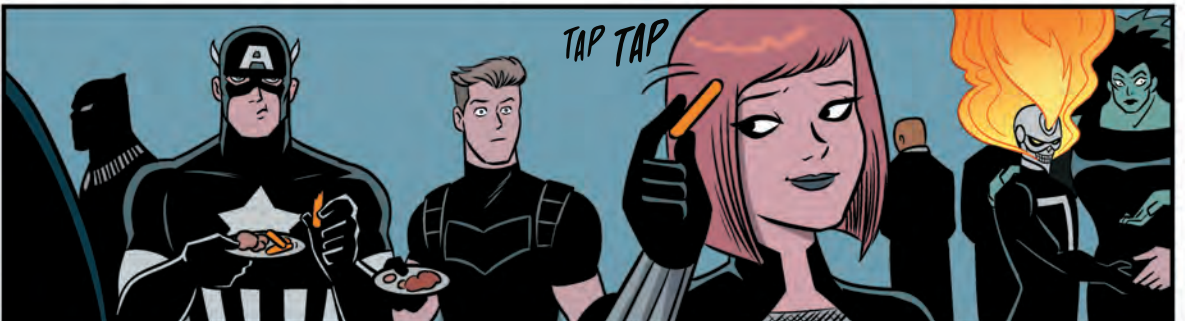


Are you kidding?



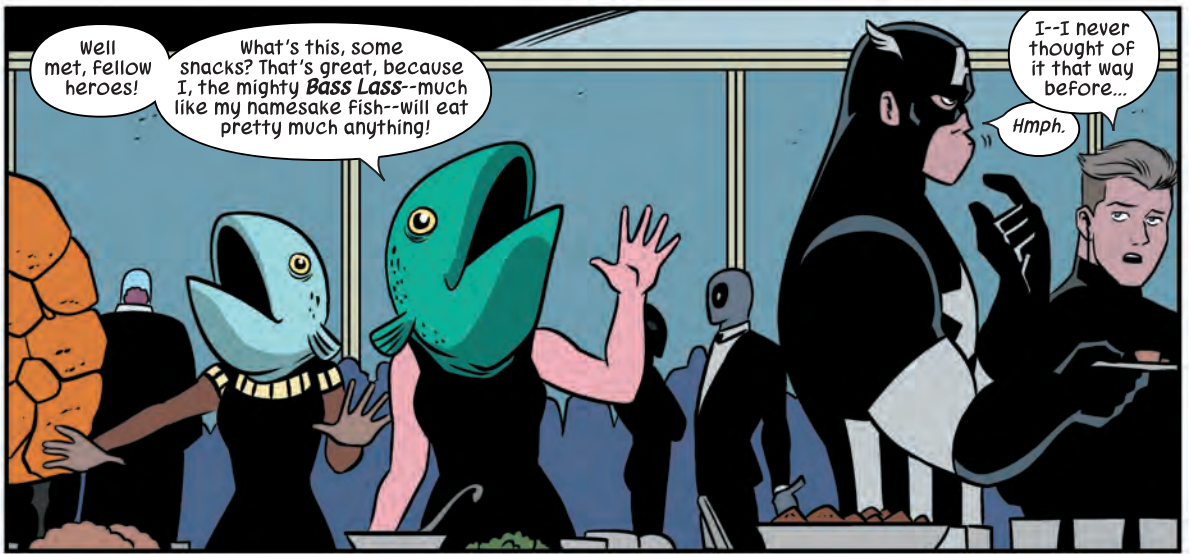
If I ever get married in the future, I promise you I'll be head to toe in black. And then if my partner dies, I'll be ready for that too.

Black Widow has clearly never been on a construction site at night and wanted to stay visible for safety! Fashion demands you accessorize with a high-visibility vest at the *very* least.

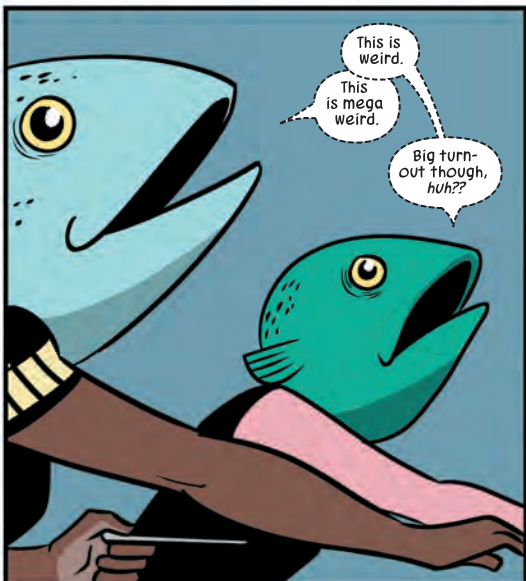


Well met, fellow heroes!

This is weird.

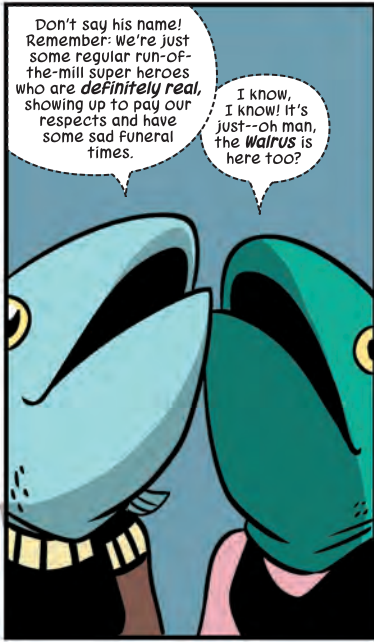
This is mega weird.

Ahem.

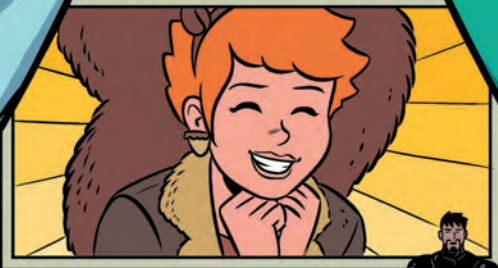
Sad Funeral times.

Iron Man

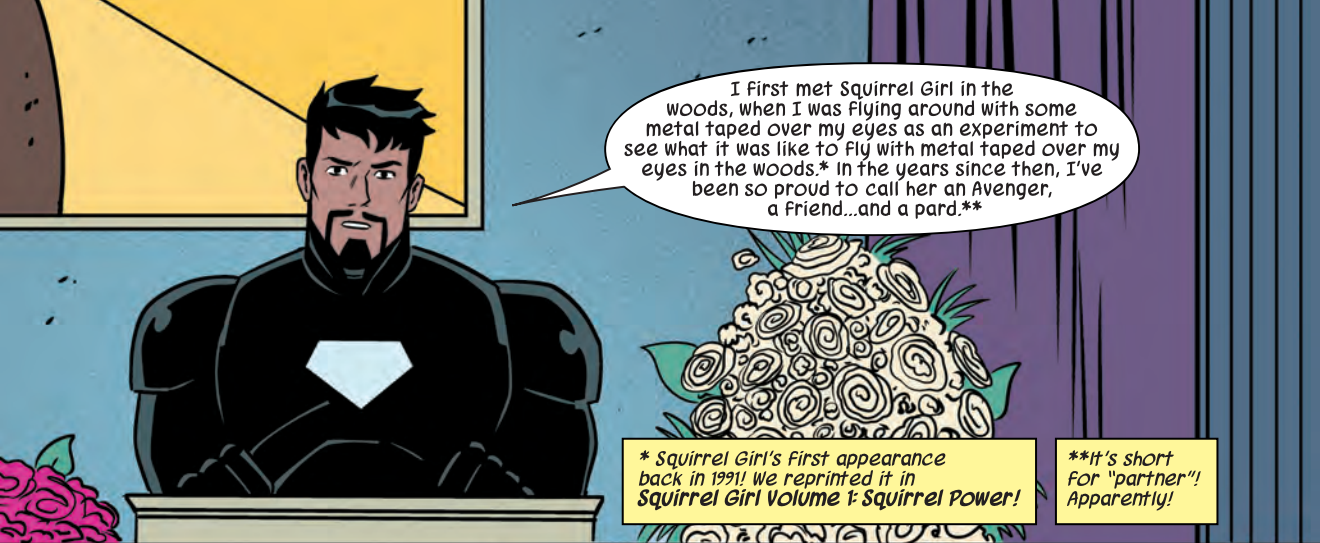
A.K.A. "Tony Stark."

Uh, I mean--aww, this Friendship that I personally wasn't involved in sounds real nice!



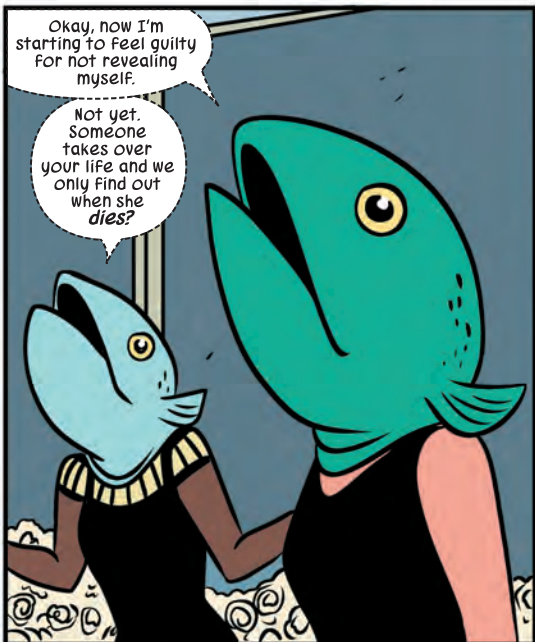
Doing what we do--it carries risk. And Squirrel Girl never shied away from it. She'd always face it head-on. Why?

Because she always knew a simple truth the rest of us sometimes forget:



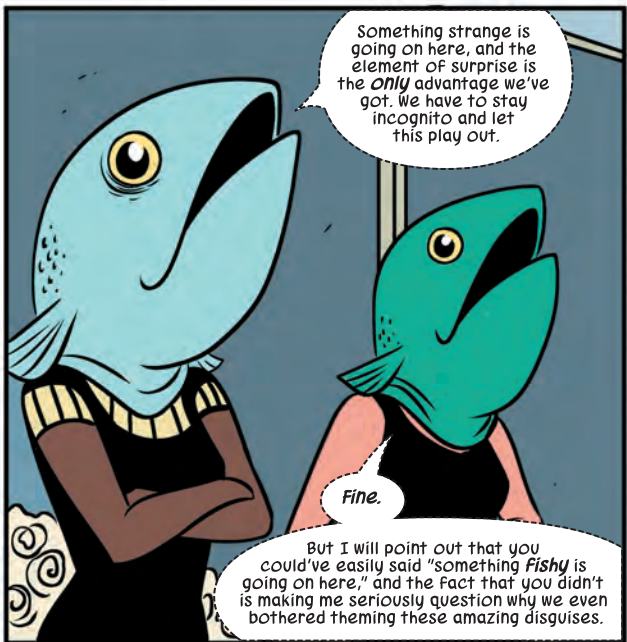
That with or without powers, the best thing *any* of us can do for each other...
