BLEHHHH (blehhhh)



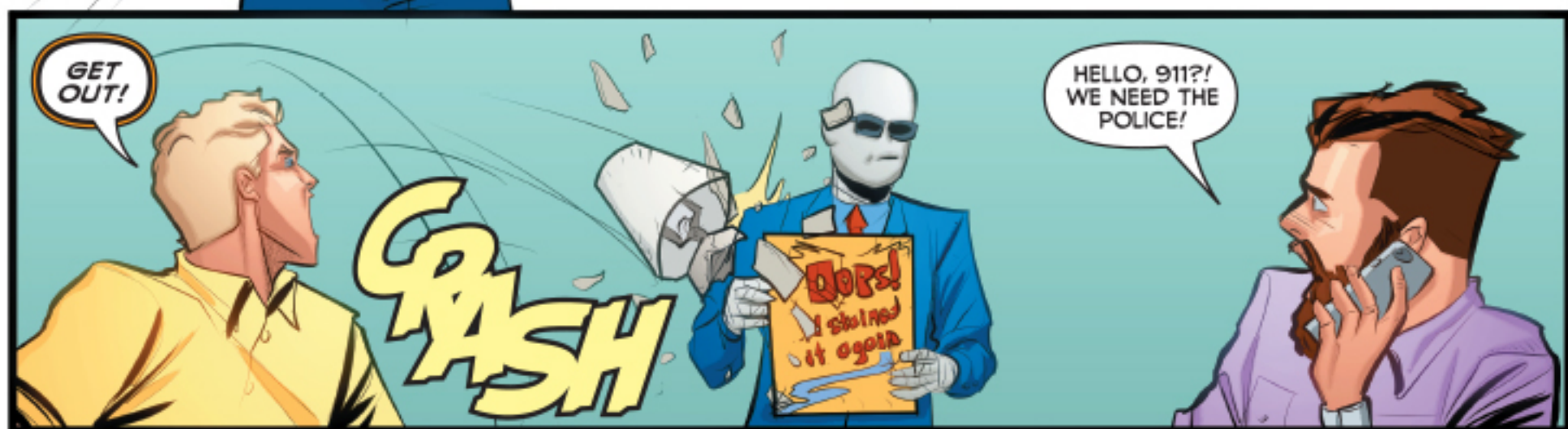
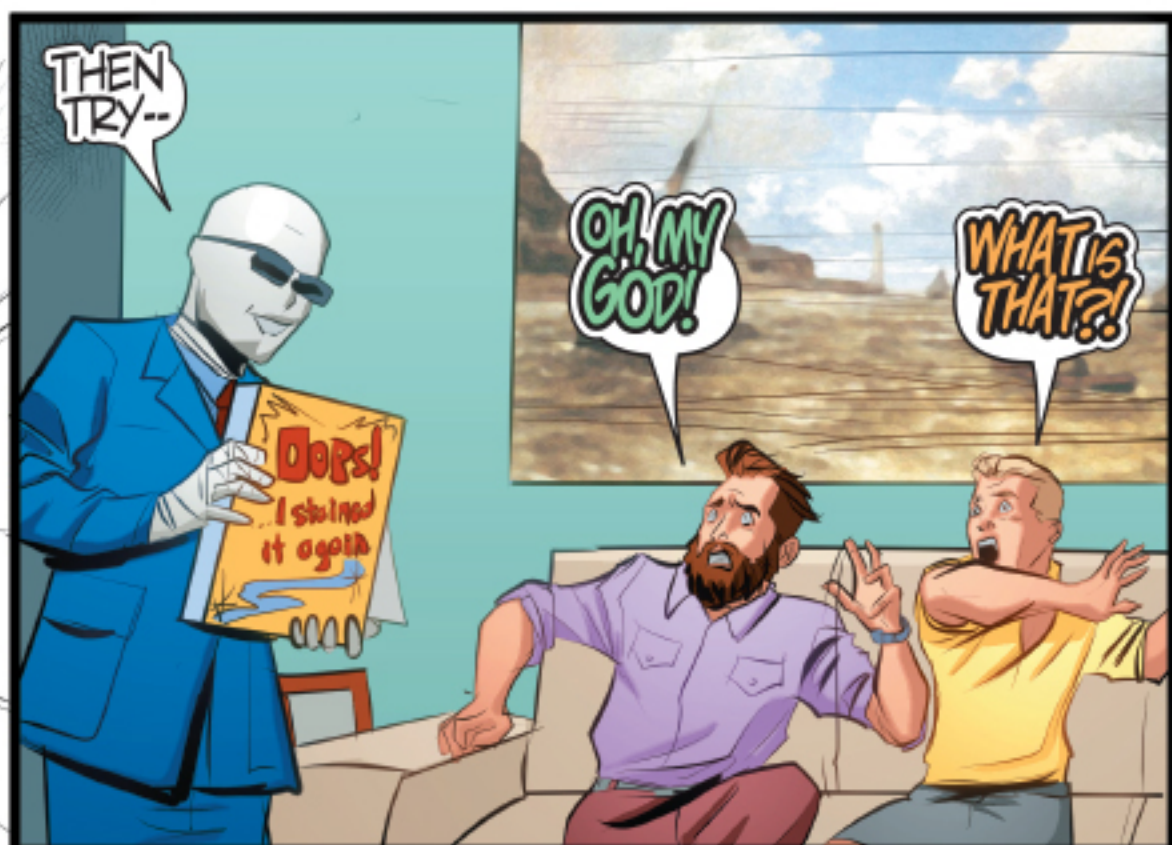
MILLIE HENDERSON
