



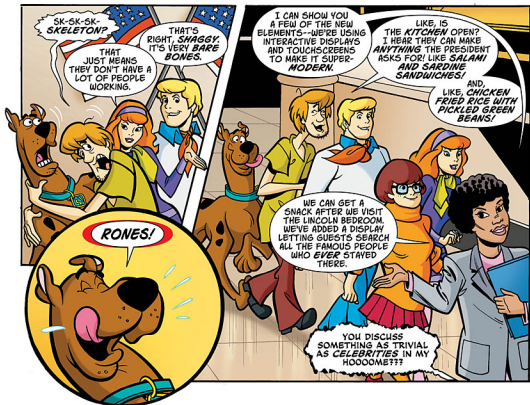
ALL THE PRESIDENTS' GHOSTS
