

HERSELF!

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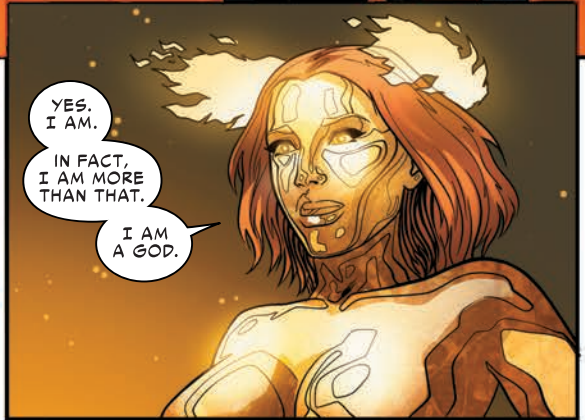

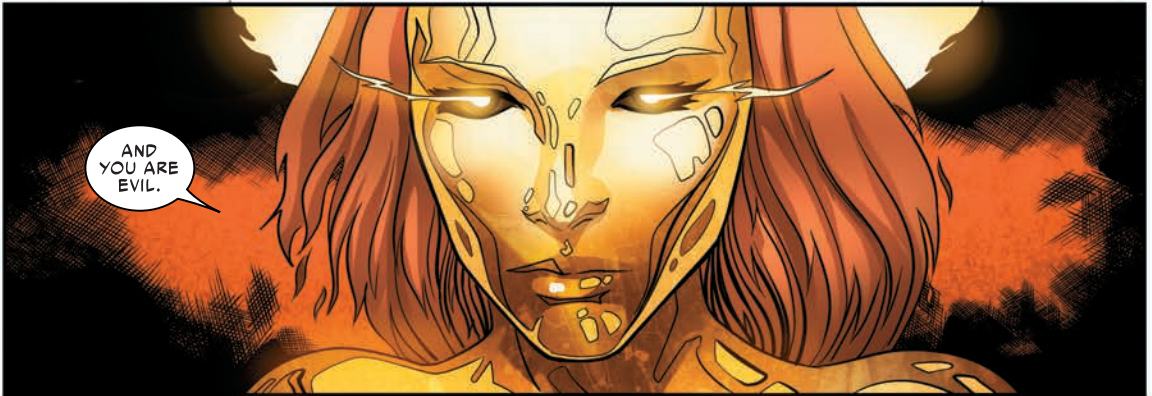

DON'T YOU THINK?



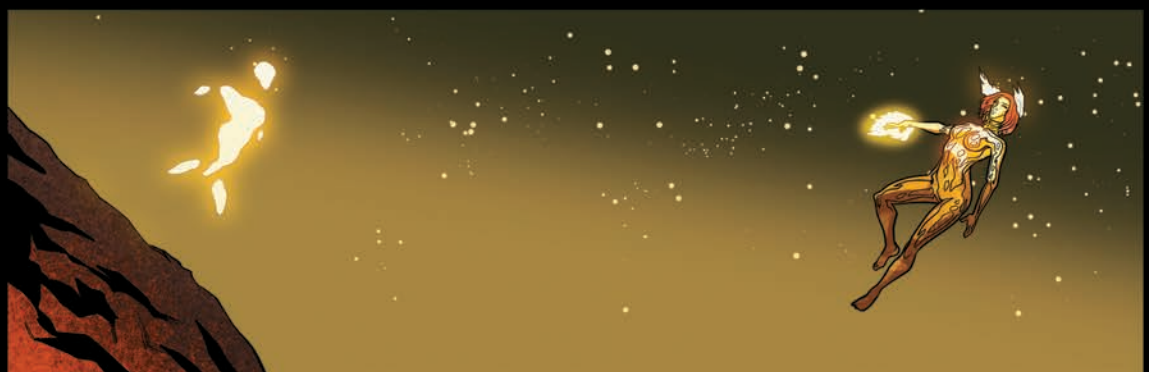
YOU, UH...YOU KEEP SAYING THAT. YOU'RE NOT A GOD.

THOR WOULD LIKELY DISAGREE.

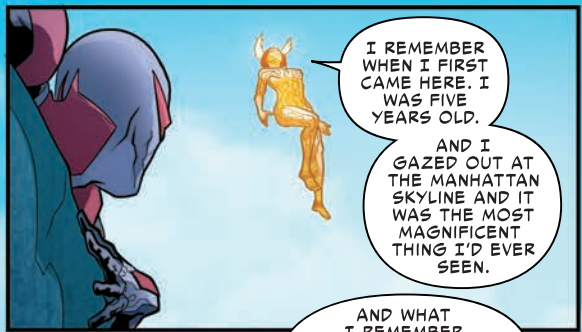
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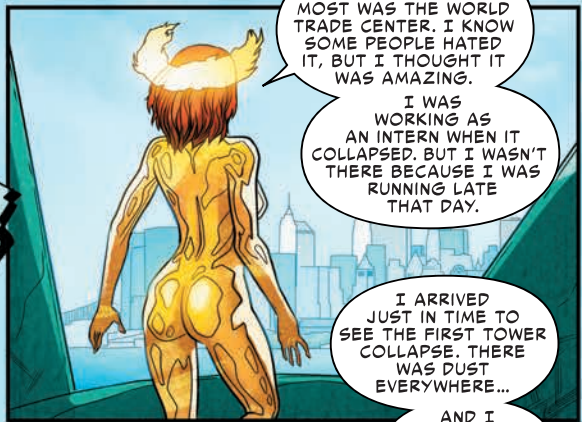

YEARS OLD.

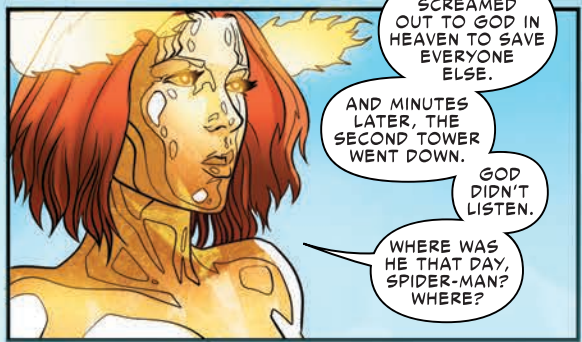
AND I
