


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Infinity Stone Properties

REALITY: Powered by the user's mastery of TIME. Can allow a person access to the Multiverse.

SOUL: Powered by the user's mastery of REALITY. Can preserve the soul to allow for life after death.

MIND: Powered by the user's mastery of SOUL. Can grant telepathy or intelligence.

TIME: Powered by the user's mastery of SPACE. Can allow a person to travel through time.

SPACE: Powered by the user's mastery of POWER. Can allow teleportation through space.

POWER: Powered by the user's mastery of MIND. Can make a person more physically powerful.

Communal Properties

On their own, the stones provide great power. But when combined, they form a circuit--a positive feedback loop granting the user INFINITE power!

Key Issues

Marvel Premiere #1 (1972): First appearance of an individual Infinity Stone. After using the stones to create Counter-Earth—a duplicate Earth on the other side of the sun—the High Evolutionary (Herbert Wyndham) bestows the green stone to Adam Warlock when he became the planet's protector.

Avengers Annual #7 / Marvel Two-In-One Annual #2 (1977): First appearance of the collected stones. The Mad Titan Thanos attempts to extinguish the stars of the universe using the Star Gem, a device powered by the energy of the stones; Thanos is defeated by a group of heroes including the Avengers, Adam Warlock and the Kree's Captain Mar-Vell.

Thanos Quest #1-2 (1990): Thanos manipulates and murders his way through the wielders of the stones—gaining limitless power when all six are collected; The origin of the stones is revealed.

Infinity Gauntlet #1-6 (1991): To win the love of Death—the cosmic embodiment of mortality—Thanos sets out to use the stones to eliminate half the population of the universe. Super-beings from Earth and the cosmos wage all-out warfare for the sake of existence!

New Avengers: Illuminati #2 (2006): The secret superhuman Illuminati braintrust collects the scattered, unprotected stones from throughout creation and hides them separately for safekeeping.

Avengers #7-13 (2010): The Avengers desperately fight to keep the stones out of the wrong hands. The Illuminati fakes their destruction and hides them once more.

New Avengers #1-3 (2013) / Avengers #34 (2014): When an alternate reality Earth threatens to collide with their Earth, the Illuminati use the combined stones to prevent this; The effort destroys five of the stones; sometime later, the sixth stone shatters.

All-New Guardians of the Galaxy #10 (2017): The Guardians of the Galaxy begin a hunt for the stones—now somehow reinstated.

Marvel Legacy #1 / Guardians of the Galaxy #147 (2017): The locations of two stones—now differently colored and in uncut forms—are revealed.









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
