DETAILS

Sheriff Knight suffered multiple bites from poisonous snakes in his municipal vehicle. Situation HIGHLY suspicious given the following files:
 1872007: At 0800, a bus transporting prisoners from the State penitentiary exploded. The vehicle and its occupants were quickly consumed in the blaze. The case has been transferred to State Police.
 1872003, 1872006: Homicides by snake bite. Evidence of escalating drug-related violence. Those cases could use State resources; Mayor Babbish has denied all our requests for additional funding.
 1872002: Red Wolf. The man who appeared in town without ID or modern clothing. Claims a murderer with a lightning gun brought him here. He should be with social services, but keeps intervening in investigations. At the scene of the fire, Red Wolf found tracks he attributed to a man with a limp. He's shouting about the Sheriff's vehicle and a limping man now, so I'm submitting this report incomplete.
