JESSICA CRUZ.


I AM A GREEN

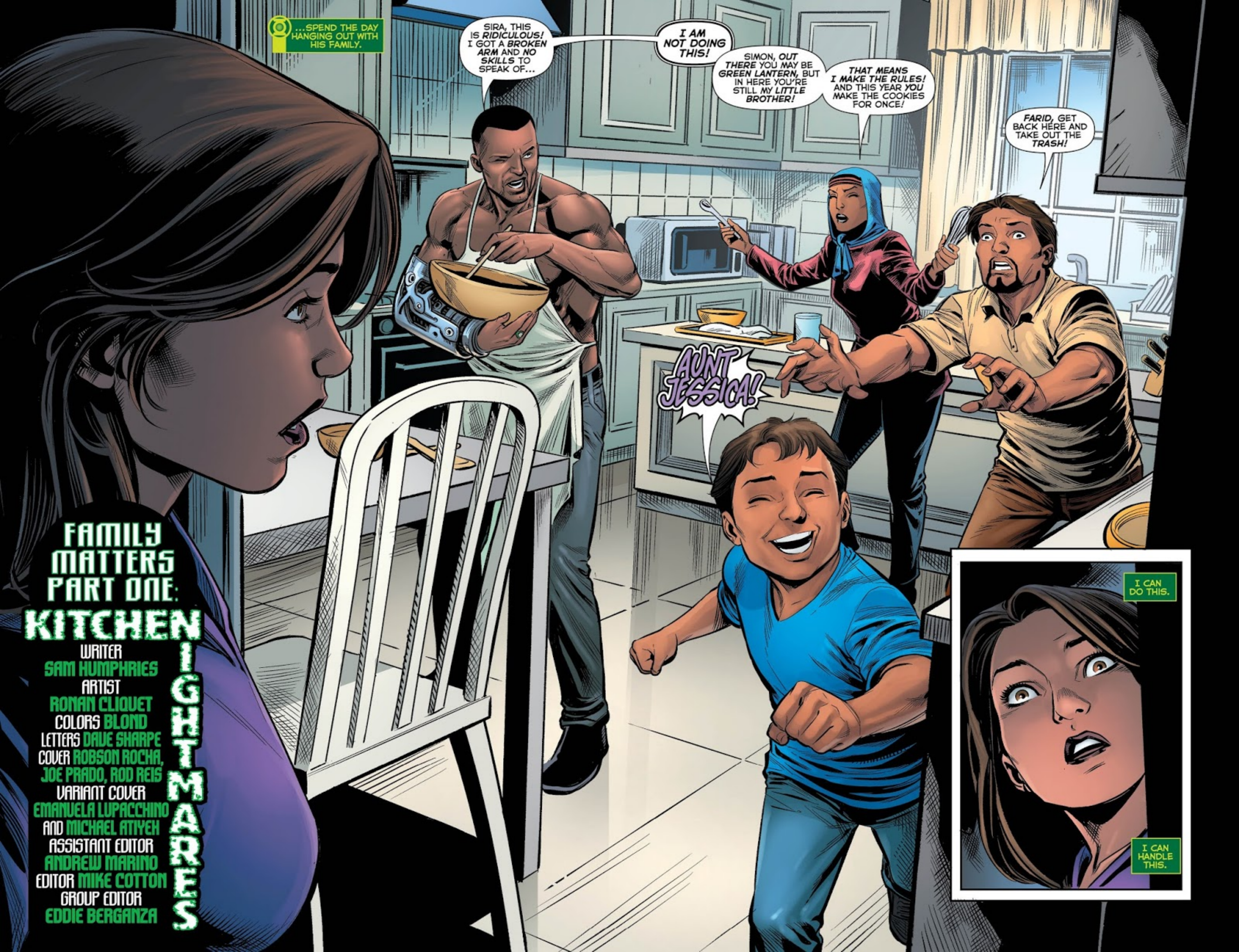
