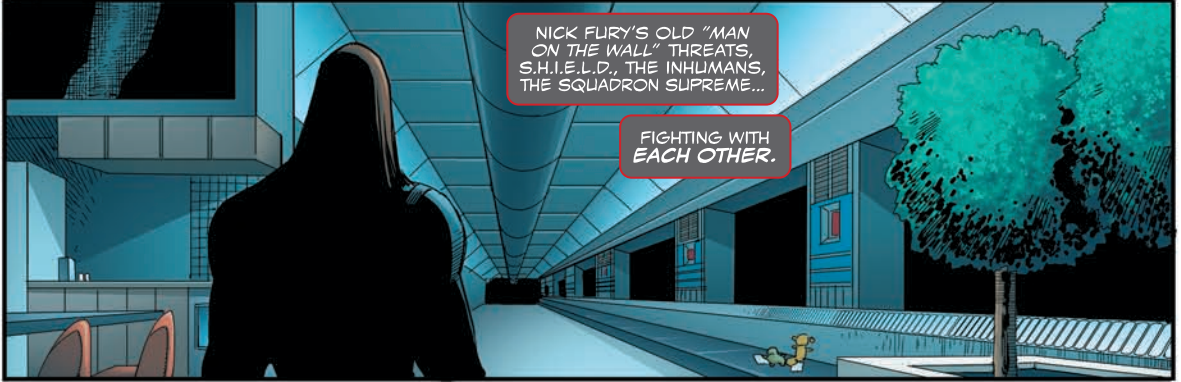

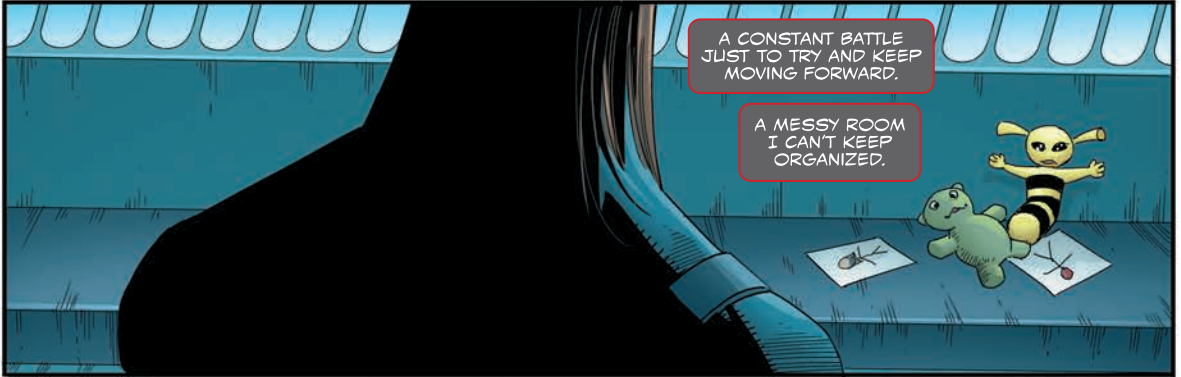


IT FEELS LIKE WE'VE BEEN FIGHTING NONSTOP SINCE WE BROKE OUT OF PLEASANT HILL.


