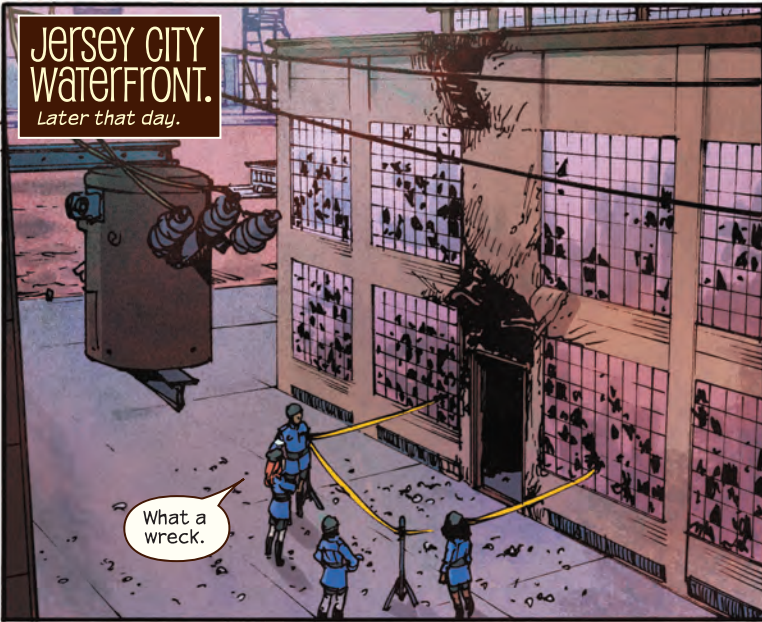


Jersey City
