I'D FORGOTTEN HOW GOOD IT WAS...IT IS. JUST BEING WITH THEM. JUST DOING NORMAL THINGS.

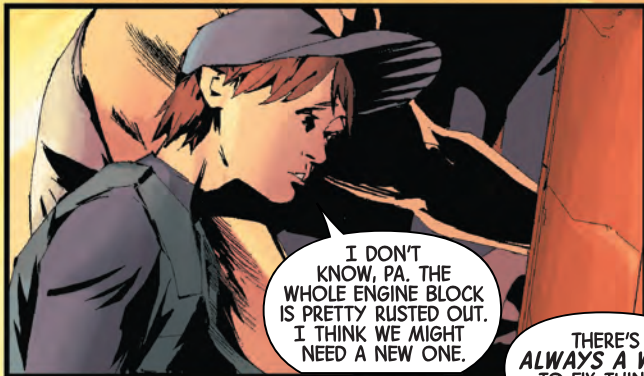
