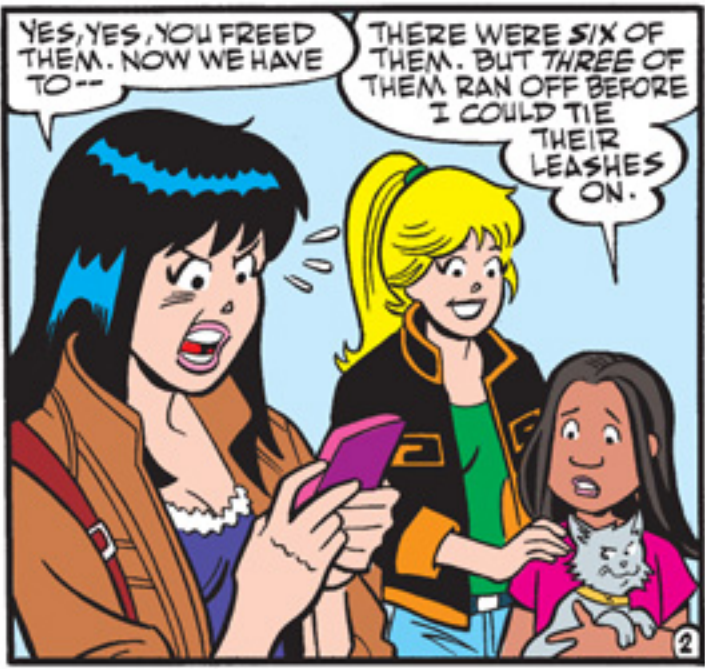
THAT'S TOO BAD, BUT WE DON'T HAVE TIME TO --



A WEEK AGO HE TOOK OFF, AND NOBODY CAME TO THE FARM TO TAKE CARE OF THE ANIMALS. SO...

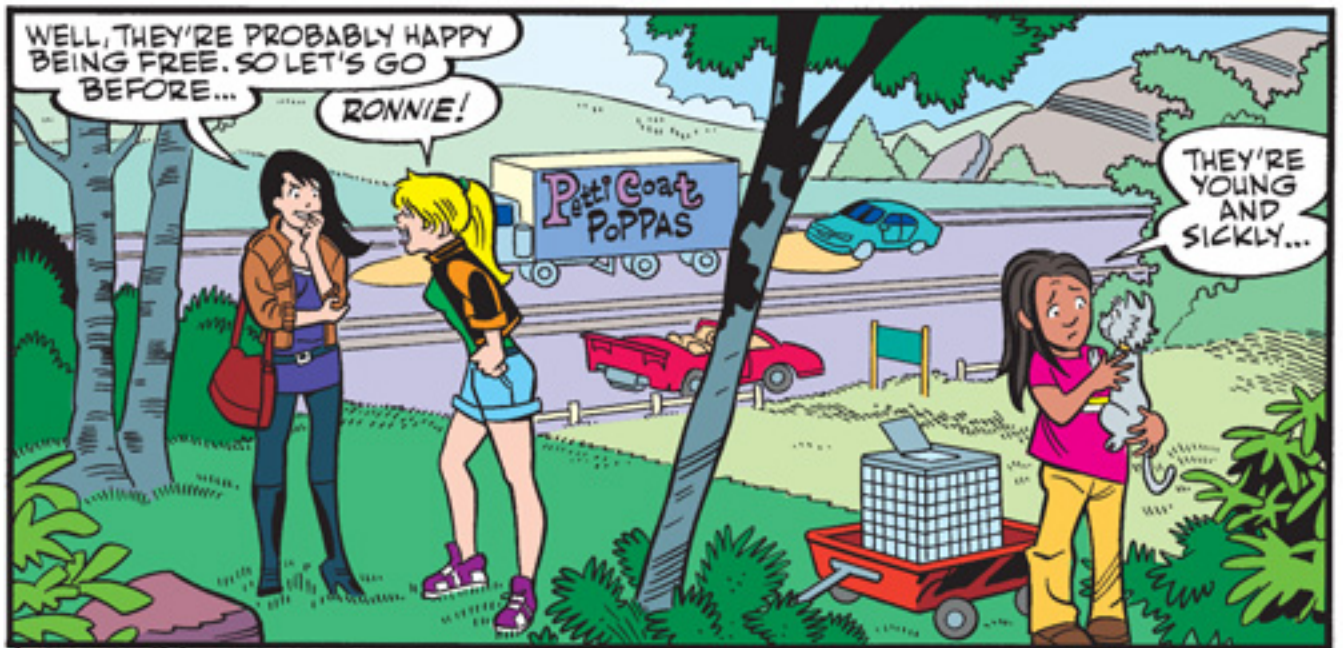
YOU "RESCUED" THEM.

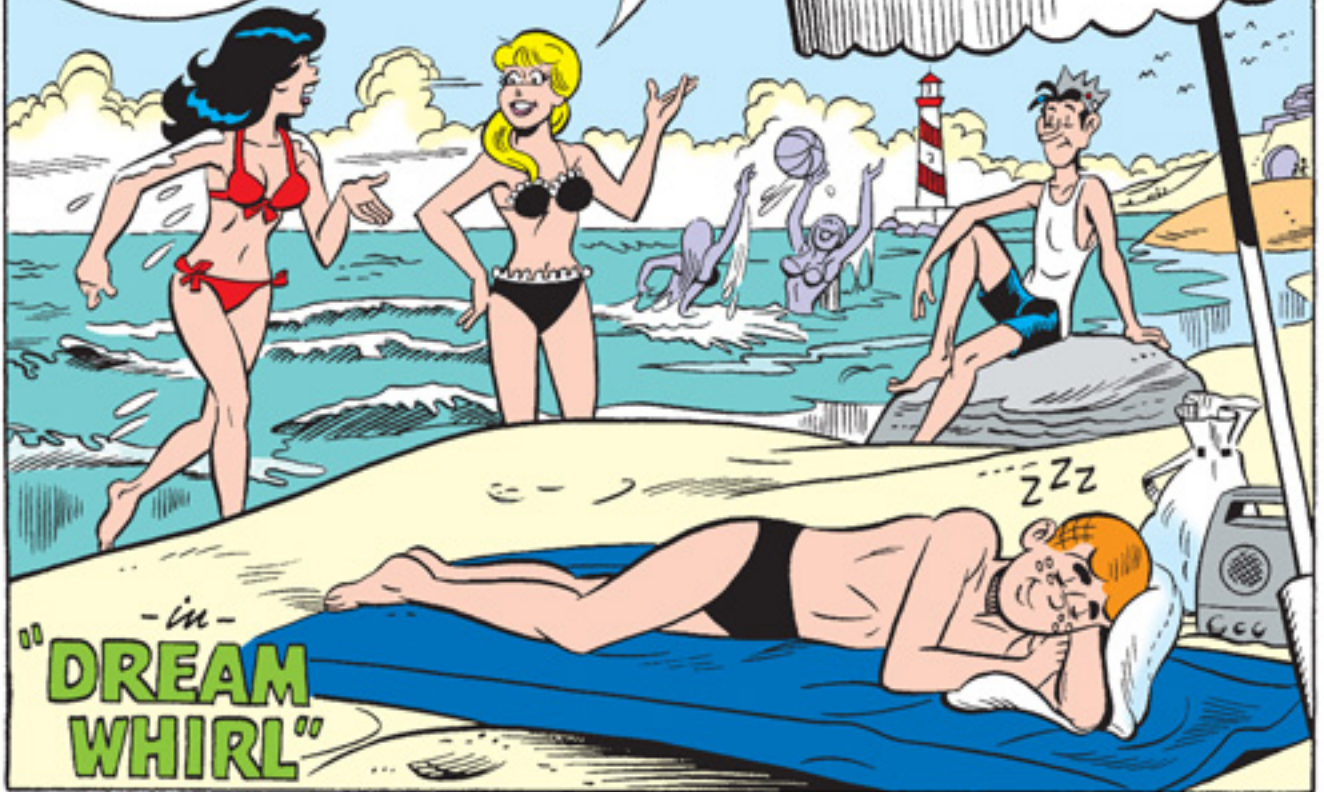

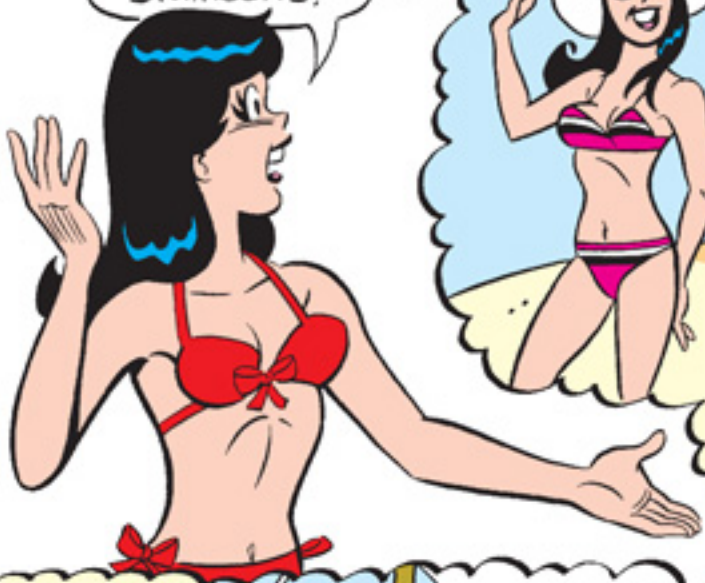
