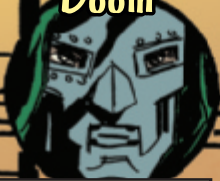

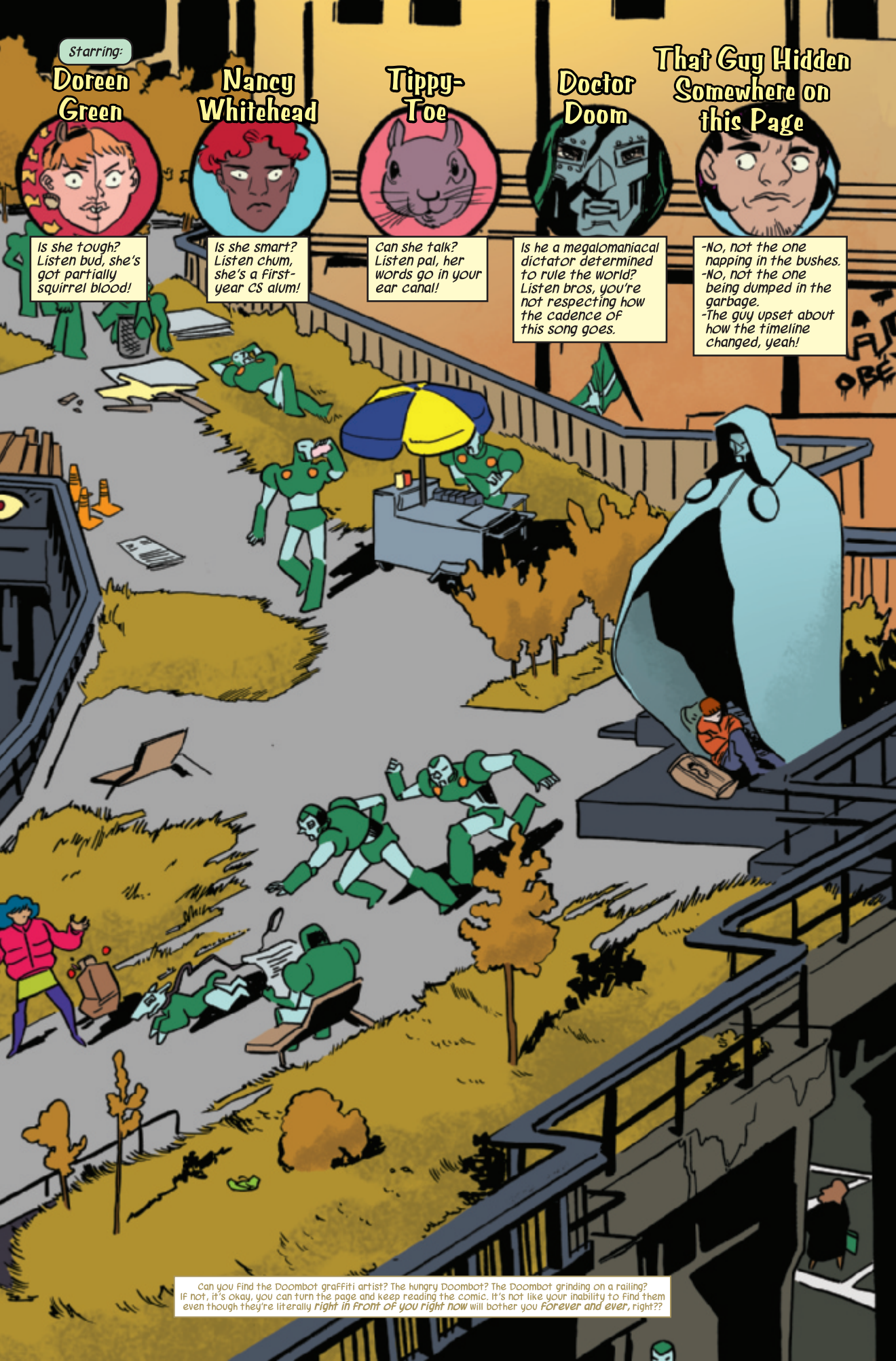
Is she tough? Listen bud, she's got partially squirrel blood!

I'm not sure we *can* beat him. He's *Doctor Doom*, you know? He's an actual *doctor of doom*.

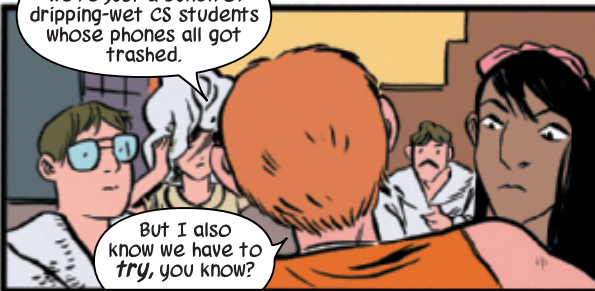

But I also know we have to *try*, you know?

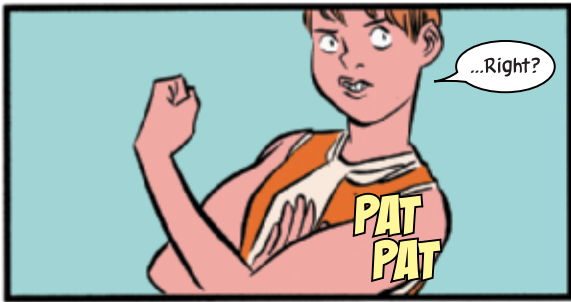

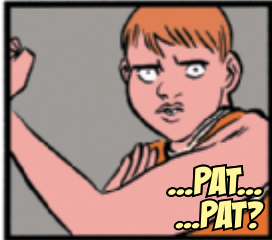


I don't want people looking me up years from now and finding a photo that's captioned all--

No, no, the time machine!



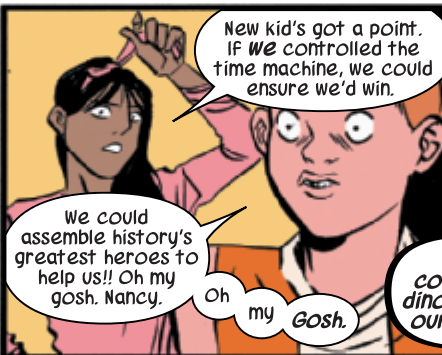
Look, we can't beat Doom. And if we *could*, he'd just go back in time and stop us from winning, right?
