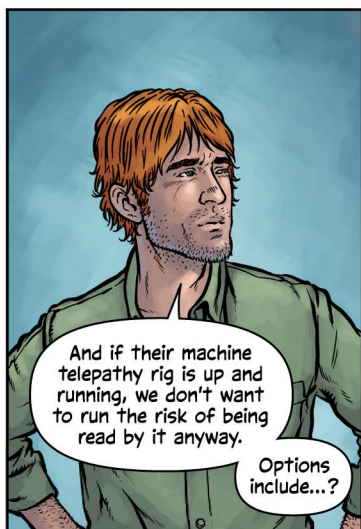
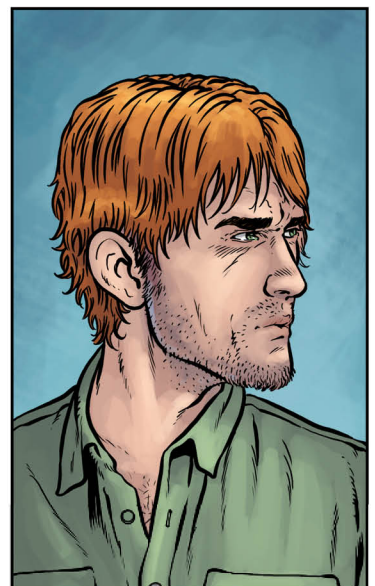

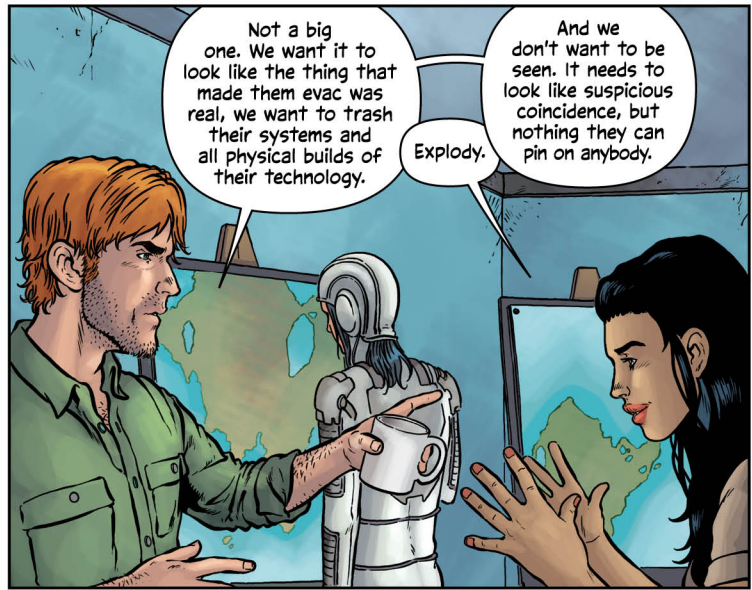

Not a big one. We want it to look like the thing that made them evac was real, we want to trash their systems and all physical builds of their technology.

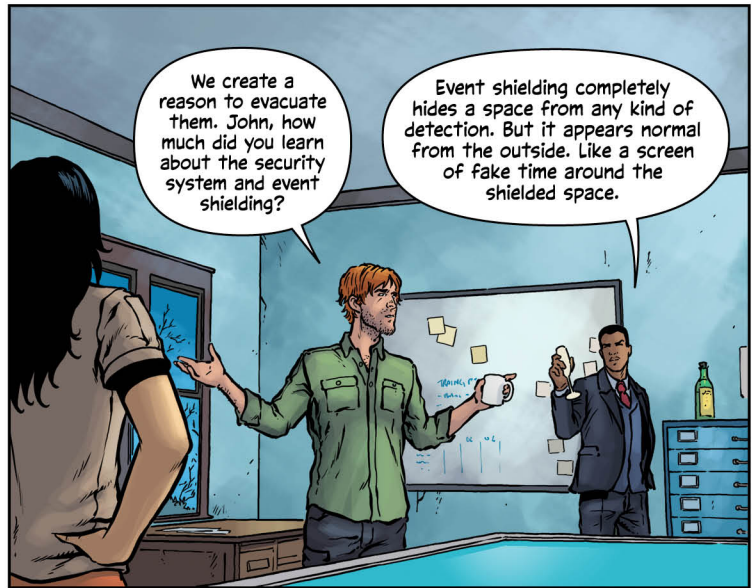
Explody.

Ken. Those little bug things Angie Spica threw at the CAT at Camp Hero.

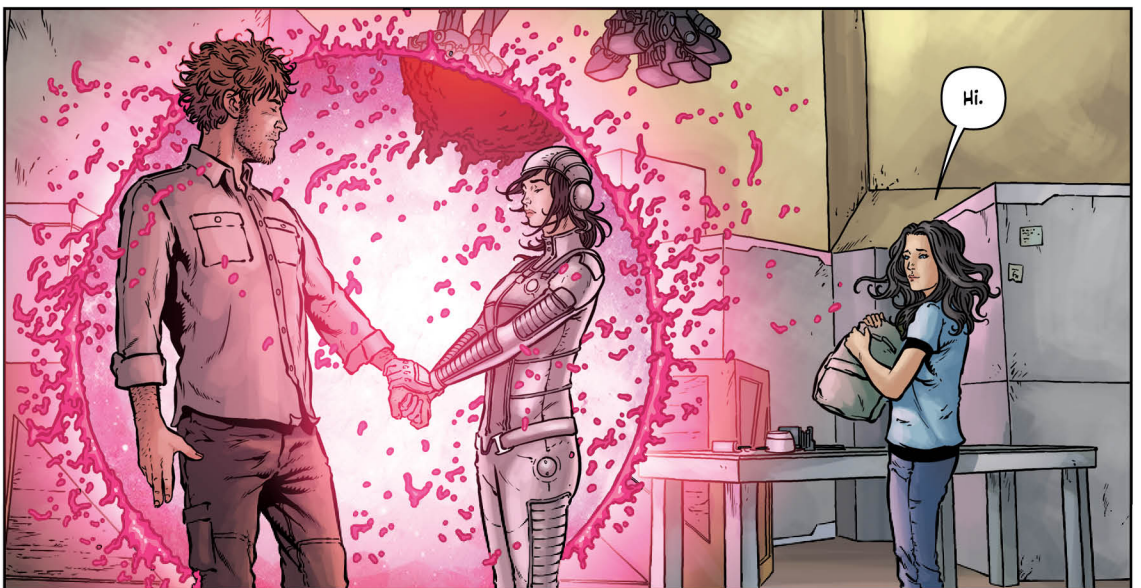
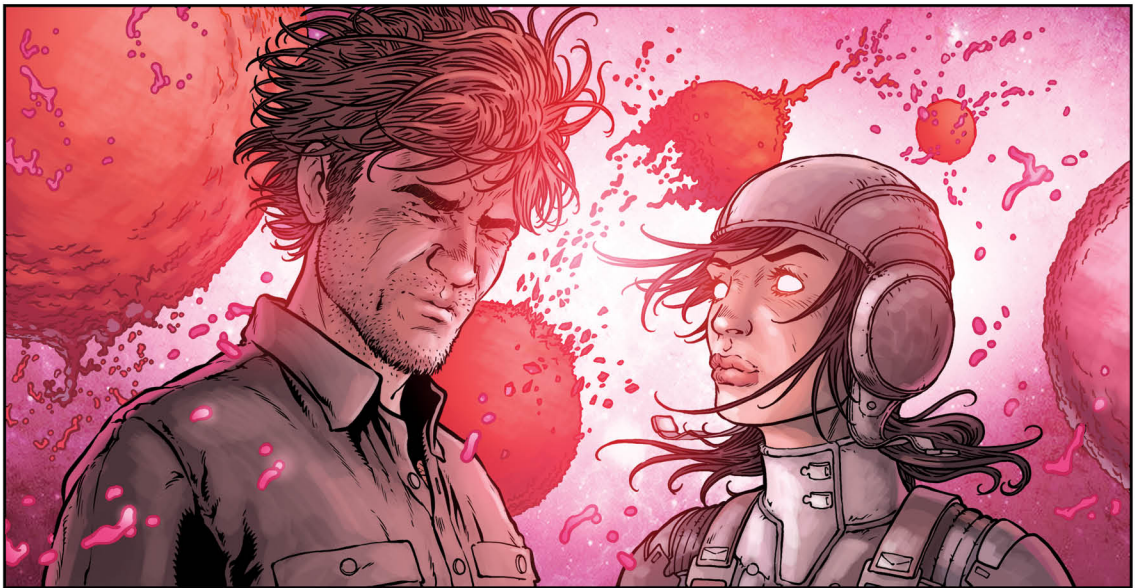
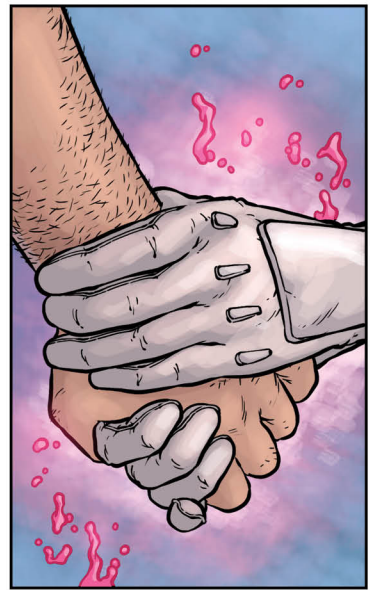
What if Adri could jump one of those in, and we could run the hack on their systems through it?

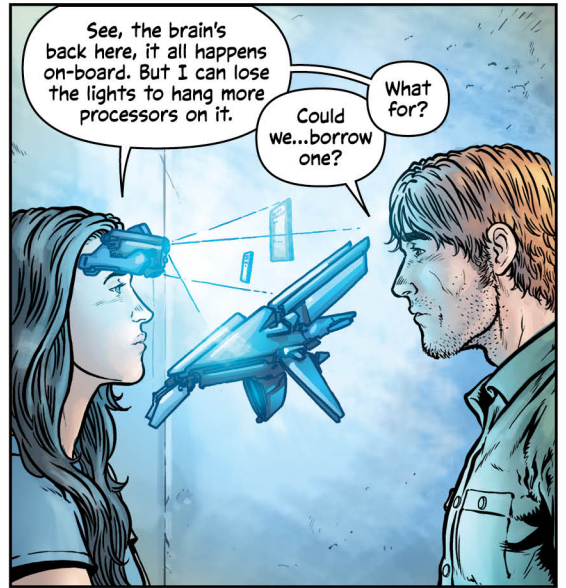
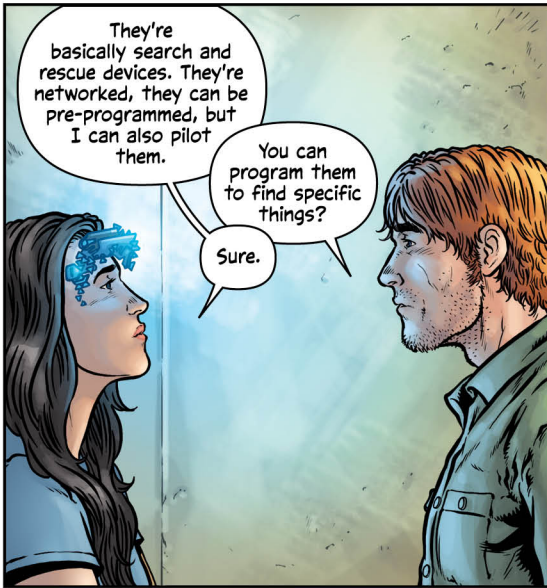
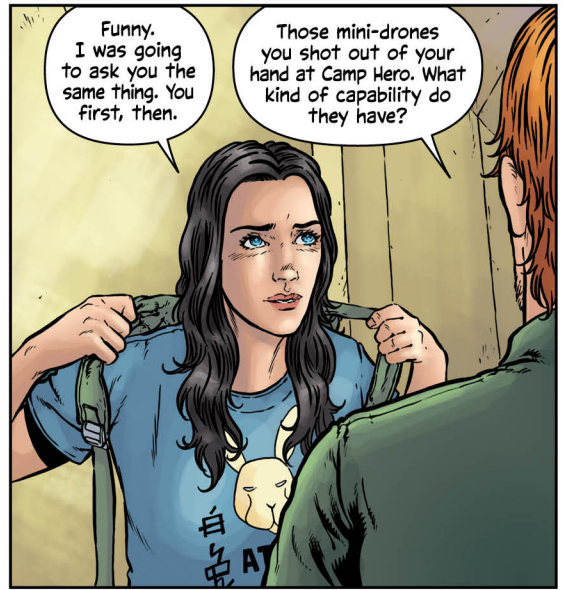


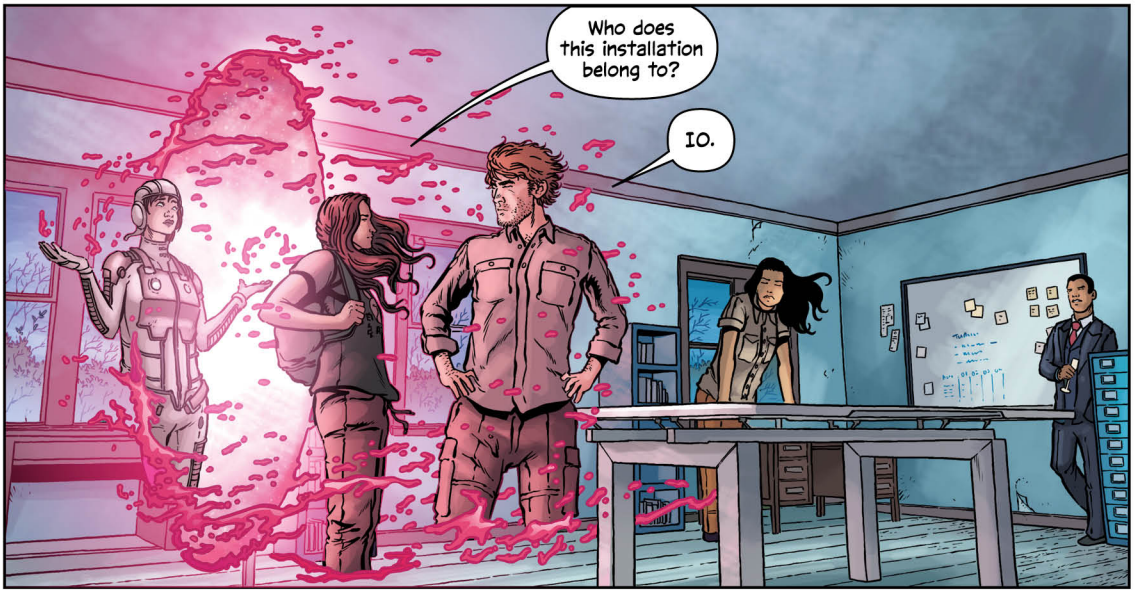
I know nothing about them. It's just a what-if.

I could definitely fit explosives in one. The rest? Who knows.

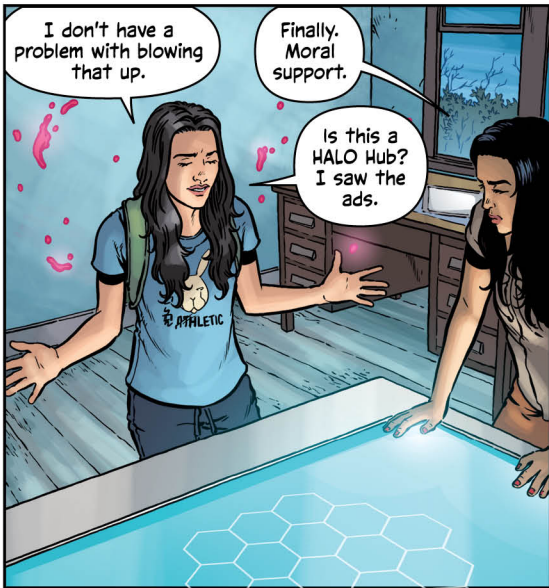

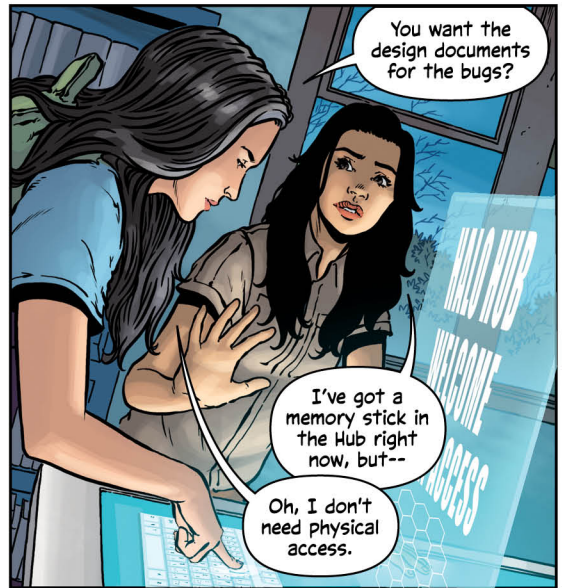

You want the design documents for the bugs?

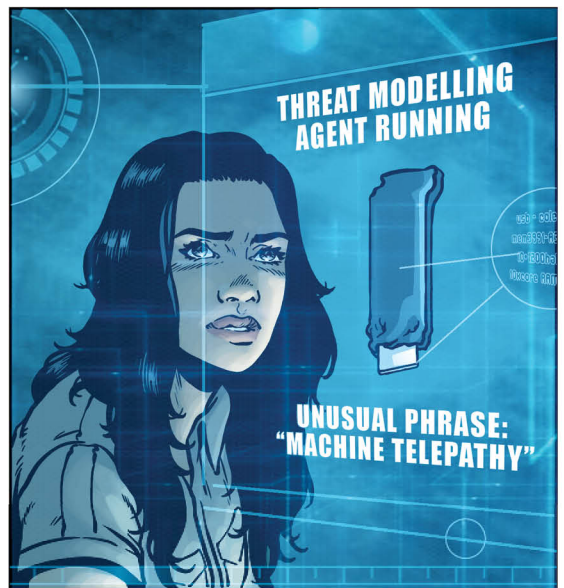
I've got a memory stick in the Hub right now, but--
