back to the way it was.

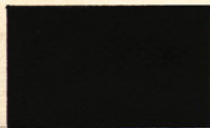
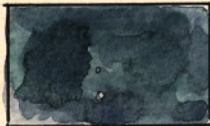
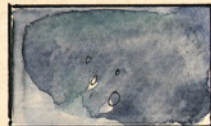
