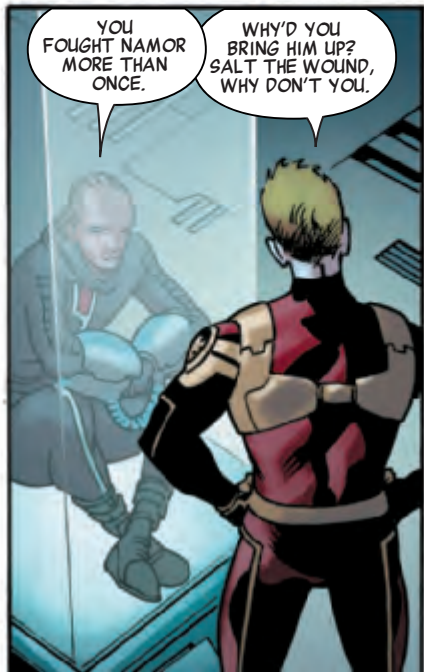
SO, EVERY TIME I LOOK, I SEE SOMETHING EXCITING.
