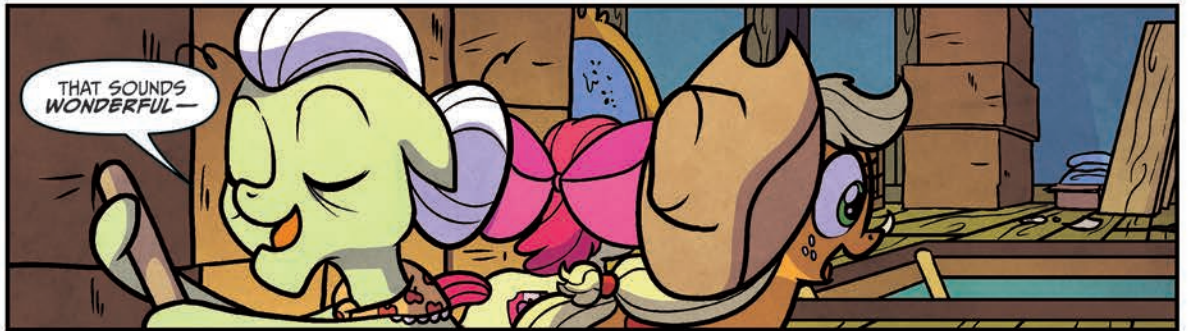


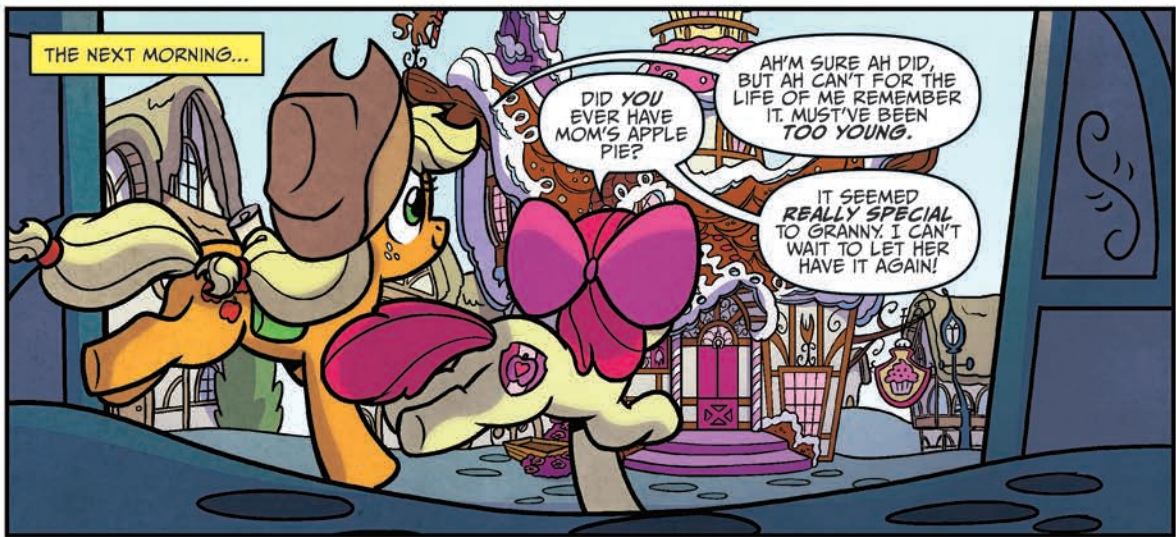
WHUT'S THIS? BUTTERCUP'S FAMILY APPLE PIE.
